- Glock mag well
- Retention plug piece
- One (1) 6-32 x 1/2" socket head cap screw

CAUTION: REMOVE MAGAZINE AND VISUALLY

CHECK CHAMBER TO MAKE SURE THAT

FIREARM IS UNLOADED.

Before beginning the installation of the JP Magazine Well, note the angle and minimal resistance of the socket head screw as it threads into the retention plug. During the installation, the insertion of the screw will not be visible, and it may become crossthreaded. If the screw resists at all, back it out and try again ir the screw will likely break and ruin the plug.

Begin by inserting the retention plug into the cavity at the rear of the grip frame so that the threaded hole is on the bottom. Hook the front of the magazine well over the front of the magazine opening on your Glock, and rotate it onto the gun. Using a 7/64" hex key, install the 6-32 socket head cap screw and tighten. You may want to use a drop of removable thread locker like Loctite 242 on the screw.
